On 12/02/09, the CAOs were notified that display issues were occurring on DX Exchange 3 (Bendex). The CAOs were given specific steps to ensure the correct entry of both the RSDI income and the Medicare B premium. In MA LTC cases it is important to enter the correct amounts to ensure accurate billing of the individual's payment toward cost of care.

DX Exchange 3 will display with an individual's RSDI as follows:

When the Bendex shows both the gross income and the Medicare B premium with a difference of 10 cents over the current standard of \$96.40, the CAO must decrease the income and Medicare B premium by 10 cents in CIS. In this example the CAO would enter income of \$1261.40 on the CAUNRD screen and

\$96.40 on a CAMEDX screen in CIS. See Q3343 for additional information on the display issues.
