Subject: Application Interview Rescheduled Beyond 30 Days

Regarding the 98% timeliness goals for application processing, what is the best way to handle an Intake application that the client requests be rescheduled beyond the 30 days? Should the original AP be rejected using code 325 on the 31st day and a new AP# be assigned?

Response By: Barbara Hummel

No, do not reject the application using code 325. Code 325 is used for applications that are rejected in error. There is no notice that would be sent using code 325. Based on Food Stamp Handbook 504.61, if the household is the cause of the delay, the County Assistance Office should send a PA/FS 162 notice to deny the application by the 30th day following the date of application. Reason code 047 (Failure to Keep Appointment) is more appropriate. However, the current text provided under that reason code is not adequate when an applicant schedules an appointment after the 30th day.

The CAO should investigate with the household if a hardship exists. If a hardship exists as per OPS Memo 06-05-02, Waiver of Face-to-Face Interview at Application for the Food Stamp Program, the CAO should offer the household a telephone interview.
