Due to a change in the law beginning July 1, 2012, the penalties for failure to meet work requirements, unless you have good cause or are exempt from work participation, have changed.

- 1st violation – You will be ineligible for a minimum of 30 days and until you demonstrate and maintain compliance for a period of at least one week. If you are disqualified for 90 days, your entire family will be disqualified until you demonstrate and maintain compliance for a period of at least one week.
- 2nd violation - You will be ineligible for a minimum of 60 days and until you demonstrate and maintain compliance for a period of at least one week. If you are disqualified for 60 days, your entire family will be disqualified until you demonstrate and maintain compliance for a period of at least one week.
- 3rd violation – Your entire family will be permanently disqualified.
