Dear

You are eligible for Medicaid, also called Medical Assistance from the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services because you have been found eligible to receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) by the Social Security Administration. You will receive a Medical Access Card in the mail if you do not already have one. As long as you are eligible for SSI, you will be eligible for Medicaid.

- Show this card each time you are requesting medical services which are to be paid for by the Department of Human Services.
- If you are unable to locate persons in your area who provide medical services under the Medicaid Program, contact the county assistance office at the address or telephone number listed. If you have any questions about the medical services available to you under the Medicaid program, contact your medical provider.
- If you have any questions about the use of the Access Card or Medicaid, contact the county assistance office at the address or telephone number listed.
- If you have any medical insurance, contact the county assistance office at the address or telephone number listed and give them your insurance information.
- You are eligible for Medicaid effective . If you have any medical bills beginning with this date which have been paid or are unpaid, contact the county assistance office at the address or telephone number listed.
