No <u>Elderly</u> (age 60 <i>or older</i> )/ Disabled member <u>and</u> no member sanctioned or disqualified	160% FPIG	No Limit
Households with a disqualified or sanctioned member	130% FPIG	\$2,250
Households with a disqualified or sanctioned member and an Elderly/Disabled member	100% FPIG (net test)	\$3,500*

Households having an Elderly/Disabled member with	100% FPIG	\$3,500*
income above 200% FPIG	(net test)	

\* The change from \$3,250 to \$3,500 was implemented October 1, 2017 as a result of the annual Mass Grant Change.
