Dear ██████████:

While the original request was to waive 55 Pa. Code § 2800.56(b)(2), the request has been corrected to waive 55 Pa.Code § 2800.64(a)(1)- (3), which is granted under the authority of 55 Pa.Code § 2800.19 due to ██████████ requiring time to attend the assisted living administrator orientation program as well as the 15-hour Assisted Living Administrator's Training Program and competency test.

2800.64 Administrator training and orientation

(a) Prior to initial employment as an administrator, a candidate shall successfully complete the following:

- (1) An orientation program approved and administered by the Department.*
- (2) A 100-hour standardized Department-approved administrator training course. The training provided for in 2800.69 (relating to additional dementia-specific training) shall be in addition to the 10-hour training course.*
- (3) A Department-approved competency-based training test with a passing score.*


This waiver is granted under the following conditions:

1. This waiver applies to ██████████, employed by Spiritrust Lutheran-The Village at Sprenkle Drive, located at 1802 Folkemer Circle, York, Pennsylvania 17404.
2. ██████████ shall attend the orientation course approved and administered by the Department, scheduled for September 1, 2021.
3. ██████████ shall complete the 15-hour Assisted Living Administrator training course, scheduled for August 20-21, 2021.

4. [REDACTED] shall pass the 15-hour Assisted Living Administrator training competency test, to be scheduled after completion of the training course.
5. Documentation of training and educational qualifications of [REDACTED] shall be kept by SpiritTrust Lutheran-The Village at Sprengle Drive in [REDACTED] personnel file and made available to the Department upon request.
6. [REDACTED] shall be provided supervision and guidance by [REDACTED], a qualified assisted living administrator, until such time that [REDACTED] meets the the assisted living administrator training requirements

The Department of Human Services will review this waiver during its annual inspection to determine compliance with the preceding conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions of this waiver or with other requirements of 55 Pa.Code Chapter 2600 may result in termination of this waiver or other licensing action.
