#### **Description of Violation**

The medications include: Bumetanide 0.5mg give 1 tablet two times a day for \_\_\_\_\_\_ Paricalcitol 2 mcg give1 capsule once a day for \_\_\_\_\_\_ Potassium Chloride one capsule daily, Psyllium husk packet give 1 packet once a day for \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, Simvastatin 20 mg give 1 tablet daily for \_\_\_\_\_\_. From 8/5/21 to 8/16/21 resident # 1 was not administered their prescribed medications.

Plan of Correction Accept

Executive Director immediately implemented a procedure that all medications sent to the pharmacy for new admissions or new orders will be reviewed by LPN on duty or DOW. DOW educated and coached LPN who reviewed admission medications. A meeting was held with pharmacy and all medication technicians and LPNs on 8/31/2021. Director of Wellness and or Executive Director will continue to review policies and procedures with medication technicians and LPNs for accuracy ongoing to prevent further admission errors. Education and audits of MAR's will be ongoing by the Director of Wellness and Executive Director.

To complete the 2 Step Plan of Correction Process, (POC), upon Resubmission of the POC, The Adm will send in copies of Staff Training, and any documents that were created or updated to track or remind staff in complying with this regulation.
