1. Requirements

2600.

- 187.a. A medication record shall be kept to include the following for each resident for whom medications are administered:
 - 13. Date and time of medication administration.

Description of Violation

The home's medication administration record (MAR) does not list a clock time for administration of residents' medication except for a few exceptions. Instead, the MAR lists Early AM, AM, Afternoon, Evening, and PM. For example, resident #1 is prescribed Amlodipine 5 mg and Aspirin 81 mg once daily. The home schedules these meds at AM. Resident #1's Feb MAR does not indicate the exact time of the administration of these medications.

Resident #2 is prescribed Eliquis tab 2.5 mg every 12 hours and Fluoxetine 20 mg once a day. The home schedules these meds at AM&PM and AM, respectively. Resident #2's Feb MAR does not indicate the exact time of the administration of these medications.

Repeated Violation: 9/16/21

Plan of Correction

In accordance with 187a, the community will revise the MAR to show an exact time (8am, 6pm etc) for administration per medication, as specified by the prescriber, and updated by pharmacy. Therefore, the initialed MAR will indicate the medication was administered within 60 minutes plus or minus the specified time. **Completion Date:** 04/30/2022

187.b. The information in subsection (a)(13) and (14) shall be recorded at the time the medication is administered.

Description of Violation

Resident #3 is prescribed Gabapentin 100 mg, Nystatin POW 10000, and Tamsulosin 0.4 mg. Resident #3's Feb MAR does not include the initials of the staff person who administered PM dose of these meds on 2/20/2022.

Repeated Violation: 9/16/21

Plan of Correction

This was an unusual oversight by a newer med-tech.

We have recently conducted training (2/28/22) and continue to conduct ongoing education for med techs to ensure they continue to document and initial for each medication as administered. Med techs will be held accountable by the HWD to - for each shift - to verify all meds are delivered as prescribed to include staff initials as well as documentation for any missed or late meds.
