Work and work-related activities may include getting a paid job, doing community service, job search, or other education, or training activities that will help prepare you for a job; or
- 2. Prove that you are exempt from or have good cause not to meet the work requirements and sign a new AMR; or
- 3. Say that you are willing to comply with work requirements and sign a new AMR accepting a referral to a contracted program.
