## Did you know...that working pays?

**T**hat's right. As a working family, the federal government might owe you money. You may qualify to have your taxes done for free. Pennsylvania also offers tax credits for low income workers. It pays to work and to check out your options!

### What is the Earned Income Tax Credit?

The **Earned Income Tax Credit** (also known as EIC or EITC) is a benefit for working people with low to moderate income. EITC reduces the amount of tax you owe and may give you a refund. To qualify for EITC you must have earned income and/or meet the additional rules for workers without a qualifying child, or have a child that meets **all** the qualifying rules. ### Where can I get free help filing my taxes?

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program of the IRS, helps you fill out your tax forms for free. IRS-certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals. To find a VITA site near you, call the IRS at 1-800-906-9887. The telephone operator can find the location nearest you. Please be patient. The lines are often busy.

### What is Tax Forgiveness?

Depending on your income and family size, you may qualify for a refund or reduction of your Pennsylvania income tax liability with the state's Tax Forgiveness program. For example, a family of four (couple with two dependent children) can earn up to \$34,250 and qualify for Tax Forgiveness. A single-parent, two-child family with income up to \$27,750 can also qualify for Tax Forgiveness.
