Subject: Incorrect Link in Operations Memorandum 15-06-01

Question: Is the information in Attachment 1 of OPS 15-06-01 correct? The "Domestic Violence Observations or Disclosures During Investigations" document seems to put an emphasis on having a protection from abuse order (PFA). Doesn't our policy specifically prohibit requiring an individual to obtain a PFA in order to proceed with good cause or exemptions?

Response By: Division of Family Assistance Date: 7/13/15

You are correct - there has been **no change** in OIM's policy on domestic violence. Guidance in CAH 108 prohibits the CAO from requiring a PFA as proof of domestic violence to obtain or continue good cause and program exemptions.

Note that the document originally linked as Attachment 1 of OPS Memo 15-06-01 did not reflect correct OIG policy. The link provided in the posting on 6/25/2015 was to an early draft of OIG's policy. **That link was corrected on July 7, 2015 and now contains the current OIG policy document.**
