Subject: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Expedited

Processing Procedure for Pending Information from Previous

Expedited SNAP Issuance

Question: We have a client that last received expedited SNAP in 2021 but did

not verify the outstanding pending information from that issuance, so the application was rejected. Are we able to issue expedited SNAP again since it has been several years or should expedited

eligibility fail due to previous pending information.

Response By: DFPPM Date: July 18, 2025

There is no time limit to failing expedited SNAP eligibility due to pending information not being received the last time the household received expedited SNAP. If the household did not provide the required pending information the last time they were certified for expedited SNAP and has not been determined eligible for ongoing benefits since the last issuance of expedited SNAP, the household is not eligible for expedited SNAP the next time they apply unless they provide pending verification for the current application.

When this situation occurs, the Income Maintenance Caseworker should process the expedited SNAP review by answering 'Yes' to the question 'Is there any postponed verification from a previous expedited issuance that the household must provide?' on the Program Request Questions screen. The system will enter the auto narrative and send the 744/2 notice associated to this rejection if expedited eligibility is failing for this reason.
