If you have a disability and you are receiving cash assistance, Medical Assistance or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, you may be eligible to receive:

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)

By applying for one of these programs, you may receive more benefits than you are receiving right now under cash assistance.

To be eligible, you must have a physical or mental disability that prevents you from working and which is expected to last at least 12 months. Children also are eligible for these additional benefits.

In each county assistance office, a disability advocate can provide you the following services:

- **✓** Help in applying for SSI/SSDI.
- \checkmark Arrange for medical exams that are required for eligibility.
- \checkmark Help in gathering medical and social history information.
- \checkmark Arrange for a lawyer to represent you in the appeal process.
