Question: Are all of the "Reasons for Referral" listed on the MRT Transmittal Form (PA 749) considered a valid disability certification for all Medical Assistance (MA) programs?

Response by: Division of Health ServicesDate: 11/19/2019

Yes. An MRT disability certification is a valid disability certification for all MA programs, no matter the reason for referral selected on the PA 749. There are different referral options because:

- Substantial Gainful Activity (SGA) is not considered for MA Card Only and Medical Assistance for Workers with Disability (MAWD). SGA is considered for Pursuing SSI/SSDI Regular DAP case.
- The MRT generates a different type of disability report for each reason for referral.

The 'Reason for Referral' options on the PA 749 and their descriptions are:

- 1. **Pursuing SSI/SSDI Regular DAP Case**: This reason is to be used for an individual that is actively pursuing Social Security Administration (SSA) benefits. They are appealing a denial and seeking the advice of the MRT for building a case that will meet SSA approval.
- Medical Card Only Child: This reason is to be used for a child that is under the age of 18 and not eligible for SSA benefits due to household income/resources. For example, a PH95 child.
- 3. **Medical Card Only Adult**: This reason is to be used for an individual that is not eligible for SSA benefits due to a reason other than disability.
- 4. **MAWD**: This reason is to be used for an individual requesting only MAWD.

NOTE: Once a child turns 18, they will need to follow the procedures listed in MAEH 315.81 and will require a disability determination from the SSA or a new MRT-Adult certification.
