Burial and Cremation Benefits

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES

The Department of Human Services (DHS) may be able to help with burial and cremation expenses.

Who is eligible?

We may be able to help if the deceased was:

- receiving cash benefits from DHS at the time of death

OR

- approved for cash benefits from DHS before death (this includes newborns lost at or soon after birth)

OR

- receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

OR

- receiving nursing home care payments continuously before January 1, 1973.

How much will DHS pay?

DHS will pay up to \$750 towards burial or cremation expenses.

Can my friends and family members help pay?

Yes, but the total value of contributions made by you and others, including money from organizations and any money that was available to the deceased, may affect the amount DHS pays.

Does it matter which funeral home I decide to use?

Yes. Your Funeral Director must be registered as a provider with us before we can help with expenses. Your Funeral Director will be able to tell you if he or she is registered for payment with DHS.
